TANDY GRANT

The Computing and Mathematics
Department received a \$1.45 million grant

from the A.R. and Marylouise Tandy
Foundation this spring. The grant will
enable the department to create new labs
—including Nanotechnology & Plasma
Physics Research, Artificial Intelligence &
Game Development, Network
Administration & Edge Computing—and a
Drone Arena. These funds will also be used
for summer coding camps that serve
community high school students and
instructors, and for items that ORU's
supercomputers, Titan and Eli, need to
operate at peak efficiency.

This summer, ORU Missions has sent teams of students to 25 nations for 2- and 4-week missions trips. 'SCHOLAR OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP'

For the second year in a row, ORU golfer Jackson Drake was named the Summit League's Scholar of the Championship. This award goes to the student-athlete with the highest cumulative undergraduate GPA participating at each of the league's 19 championships. As a History major, Jackson had a perfect 4.0 GPA. He was also named to the All-Summit League Second Team. He tied for first at the Missouri State Invitational, and had a top-five and two top-ten finishes on the course.

ELI AWARDS

The annual Eli Awards banquet is a celebration of ORU student-athletes. At the April 24 event, the women's basketball team received the top prize, the Athletic Director's Cup, which recognized the team for excelling both on and off the court. The women had a team GPA of 3.68, reached 20 wins for the first time since the 2011-12 season, hosted a WNIT game (their first WNIT appearance since 2011), and had their best start to a season since 1982 with a 15-5 record. Other awards included Top Sports Moment, Team MVPs, Academic Excellence, Whole Person Champions, and Energizer Bunny (to women's soccer's Abigail Hoffman).
